### Data subject's rights to information, rectification, erasure and restriction of processing, and the right to lodge an objection

You have the right, at any time, to **obtain detailed information** about the personal data concerning you which LJV stores.

### 3. Collection and storage of personal data and types and purposes of use

When you contact us on a business matter we collect the following information: first name, surname, addresses (residential, delivery and billing address), in some cases your membership number, information necessary for the processing and management of your enquiry or order.

When you contact us within the framework of membership we collect the following information: first name, surname, address, title, contact details (telephone and fax number, e-mail address), bank details, date of birth, information necessary for the processing and management of your membership.

The data are collected for the purposes of identifying you as our member, fulfilling contractual obligations, corresponding with you, invoicing and billing, achieving our association's objective, distributing our members' magazine "Jagd und Jäger", electronic transmission of association information, settlement of any liability claims and assertion of any claims against you.

The data is processed at your request in accordance with Art. 6 (1), sent.1, a) + b) GDPR for the specified purposes of managing your membership properly and/or processing enquiries and for reciprocal compliance with membership obligations.

The publication of members' birthdays and anniversaries in our members' magazine "Jagd und Jäger" and the associated processing of your personal data takes place on the basis of your consent and the data is processed for the purpose for which you have given your consent in accordance with Art. 6 (1), sent. 1, a) GDPR. You have the right to revoke that consent at any time pursuant to Art 7, (3) GDPR.

The personal data we collect in connection with your membership are stored until the statutory archiving periods expire and then erased, unless it is necessary to store them for longer in order to comply with a legal obligation pursuant to Art: 6 (1), sent. 1, c) GDPR such as the tax and commercial law-related archiving and documentation obligations (under the German Commercial Code, Tax Code or Fiscal Code), or you have consented to them being stored for a longer period pursuant to Art. 6 (1) sent. 1, a) GDPR.

### 4. Disclosure of data to third parties

Your data will only be disclosed to third parties for the purposes specified below.

Your personal data will be disclosed to third parties if this is necessary pursuant to Article 6 (1) sent. 1, b) GDPR to execute

your contractual or membership relationship with us. In particular, this involves the disclosure of your data to association units, to the data processors and other service providers engaged by us to execute and manage the membership contract, your order, your enquiry or to fulfil legal obligations. These include, in particular, regional units, district units and game management units, IT service companies, banks, telecommunication, debt collection, logistics and shipment service providers and print service providers. The data which is disclosed to third parties may only be used by those third parties for the stated purposes.

### 5. Data subject rights

You have the following rights:

- Art 7 (3) GDPR accords you the right to revoke your consent to us processing your personal data at any time. If you withdraw your consent, we will no longer be able to continue processing the data for which your consent was withdrawn;
- Under Article 15 GDPR you have the right to request information about your personal data which is processed by us.
- Under Article 16 GDPR you have the right to obtain the rectification or supplementation of inaccurate or incomplete personal data concerning you;
- Under Article 17 GDPR you have the right to obtain the erasure of your personal data which we store unless the data is processed to exercise the right of freedom of expression and information, to comply with a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest or to establish, exercise or defend legal claims;
- Under Article 18 GDPR you have the right to obtain restriction of processing your personal data if you contest the accuracy of the personal data, if the processing is unlawful and you reject the erasure of the personal data, if we no longer need your personal data for the purposes of processing but it is required by you for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims or, pursuant to Article 21 GDPR, you have objected to the processing of your personal data;
- Under Article 20 GDPR you have the right to receive the personal data concerning you which you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to transmit that data to another controller and;
- Under Article 77 GDPR you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority. You can generally lodge the complaint with the supervisory body at your place of habitual residence, at your place of work or at the place where we have our registered office. Our supervisory body is: The State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information in Rhineland-Palatinate, Hintere Bleiche 34, 55116 Mainz.

### 6. Right to object

If your personal data is processed by us for the purposes of our legitimate interests pursuant to Article 6 (1) sent. 1, f) GDPR, you have the right under Article 21 GDPR to object to the processing of your personal data on grounds relating to your particular situation.
